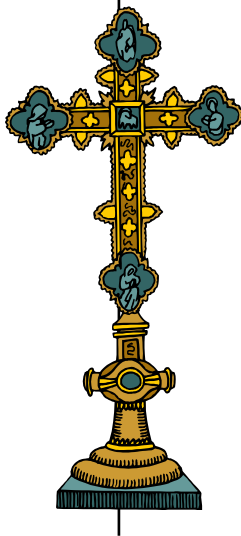

DRESS CODE

A "DRESS CODE" RECOGNIZES HOW MUCH WE AFFECT ONE ANOTHER AS A COMMUNITY, AIMING TO INSPIRE EACH OTHER TO ACHIEVE HOLINESS AND THE BEST WE CAN IN OUR STUDIES. OVER THE YEARS, EXPERIENCE HAS SHOWN THAT ACTIONS AND APPEARANCE ARE VERY CLOSELY CONNECTED. MODESTY AND CHASTITY ARE TWO OF THE TWELVE FRUITS OF THE SPIRIT: "CHARITY, JOY, PEACE, PATIENCE, KINDNESS, GOODNESS, GENEROSITY, GENTLENESS, FAITHFULNESS, MODESTY, SELF-CONTROL, CHASTITY." CCC 1832

56. *THE PRACTICE OF DECENCY AND MODESTY* IN SPEECH, ACTION, AND DRESS IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR CREATING AN ATMOSPHERE SUITABLE TO THE GROWTH OF CHASTITY, BUT THIS MUST BE WELL MOTIVATED BY RESPECT FOR ONE'S OWN BODY AND THE DIGNITY OF OTHERS. PARENTS, AS WE HAVE SAID, SHOULD BE WATCHFUL SO THAT CERTAIN IMMORAL FASHIONS AND ATTITUDES DO NOT VIOLATE THE INTEGRITY OF THE HOME, ESPECIALLY THROUGH MISUSE OF THE *MASS MEDIA*. IN THIS REGARD, THE HOLY FATHER STRESSED THE NEED "TO PROMOTE *CLOSER COLLABORATION* BETWEEN PARENTS WHO HAVE PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITY FOR EDUCATION THOSE IN CHARGE OF THE *MASS MEDIA* AT VARIOUS LEVELS, AND THE PUBLIC AUTHORITIES, SO THAT FAMILIES ARE NOT LEFT WITHOUT GUIDANCE IN SUCH AN IMPORTANT SECTOR OF THEIR EDUCATIONAL MISSION... IN FACT THE PRESENTATIONS, CONTENT, AND PROGRAMS OF HEALTHY ENTERTAINMENT, INFORMATION, AND EDUCATION TO COMPLEMENT THAT OF THE FAMILY AND THE SCHOOL MUST BE RECOGNIZED.

LADIES (GIRLS, TEENS, MOTHERS)

BLOUSES: SHIRTS MUST HAVE SLEEVES AND A NECKLINE FOUR FINGERS OR LESS BELOW THE COLLAR-BONE. **EVEN IF YOU RAISE YOUR ARMS, YOUR SHIRT SHOULD COVER YOUR MIDRIFF. ALLOW YOUR SHIRT TO BE LOOSE ENOUGH SO IT DOESN'T CLING TO YOUR BODY AND SO THAT YOUR BRA IS NOT SEEN OR OUTLINED.** INAPPROPRIATE LOGOS, SIGNS, MESSAGES, OR SHEER FABRICS ARE UNACCEPTABLE.

SKIRTS: THEY SHOULD FALL BELOW YOUR KNEE WHEN YOU ARE STANDING. FORM-FITTING AND SHEER SKIRTS ARE INAPPROPRIATE, AND SO ARE ANY THAT SHOW YOUR UNDERWEAR LINE. SLIPS ARE VERY USEFUL TO PREVENT THESE PROBLEMS. IF THERE IS A SLIT IN THE FRONT OF YOUR SKIRT, IT SHOULD BE BELOW THE KNEE; ON THE SIDE, IT CAN BE UP TO THE KNEE; AND IN THE BACK, IT CAN BE JUST ABOVE THE KNEE.

DRESSES: THE SAME GUIDELINES APPLY AS FOR BLOUSES AND SKIRTS. THE NECKLINE OF DRESSES IN BACK MUST BE FOUR FINGERS OR LESS BELOW THE NAPE OF YOUR NECK. DRESSES MAY BE SLEEVELESS BUT NOT STRAPLESS. STRAPS MUST BE AT LEAST THREE FINGERS WIDE.

PANTS: THESE SHOULD NOT CLING TO YOUR BODY, AND NO UNDERWEAR LINE SHOULD BE VISIBLE. THE WAISTLINE OF PANTS SHOULD NOT REVEAL ANY SKIN.

SHORTS: THESE CAN BE ROUGHLY EIGHT FINGERS OR LESS ABOVE YOUR KNEE WHEN YOU ARE STANDING.

GENTLEMEN (BOYS, TEENS, FATHERS)

CHURCH ATTIRE FOR BOYS IS COLLARED SHIRT, LONG PANTS, AND CLEAN SHOES.

CASUAL WEAR CAN BE SPORTS SHIRTS, JEANS, AND WALKING SHORTS.

BAGGY OR SAGGING PANTS, VISIBLE BOXERS, OR INAPPROPRIATE LOGOS OR MESSAGES ON SHIRTS ARE UNACCEPTABLE.

CAPS MAY NOT BE WORN IN CLASS.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

NATURAL APPEARANCE IS EXPECTED. THE USE OF LIGHT MAKE-UP IS PERMITTED. EXTREME HAIR COLORING, BODY PIERCING, AND TATTOOS ARE UNACCEPTABLE. SHOULD A STUDENT'S DRESS BE DEEMED INAPPROPRIATE, PARENTS WILL BE CONTACTED AND ASKED TO ENFORCE THESE STANDARDS OF MODEST DRESS WITH THEIR CHILDREN.

MAINTAINING A STANDARD OF MODEST DRESS IS SO IMPORTANT TO EVERYONE'S STATE OF HOLINESS! IT IS ALSO VERY EMBARRASSING FOR PEOPLE TO CALL TO THE ATTENTION OF ANOTHER THAT THEIR DRESS IS IMMODEST AND AN OCCASION OF SIN. WE ASK THAT STUDENTS AND PARENTS PLEASE COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE DRESS CODE. THANK YOU.
